Nonprofit Housing Repair Grant II

The Nonprofit Housing Repair Grant II will provide direct cash funding to nonprofit organizations that demonstrate organizational readiness to make minor repairs on a number of homes in a concentrated area. These nonprofits organizations may contract or use volunteer labor to conduct the housing repair. However, preference will be given to those nonprofits organizations that incorporate volunteer labor. The award for Grant II will range from \$5,000 to \$20,000. It is estimated that these grants will benefit 5-30 homes per organization.

Program Requirements:

Proposed projects can only benefit owner occupied single family homes, the project must be in a concentrated area (no longer than 1 square mile), and greater consideration will be given to project proposals that are in areas with high foreclosure rates. Proposed projects must have exterior improvements such as, home painting as the major component of proposed project.

Eligible Applicants:

Nonprofits and Faith Based organizations that have been a 501 (c)(3) for a minimum of two years.

Submit project or program proposal that complies with Program Requirements and Required Documentation as stated in the 2011 Nonprofit Housing Repair Grant II Proposal Guidelines.
