United Arts of Central Florida is pleased to announce the 2012 Artist Development Grants & Arts Administrator Grants, awarding \$32,099 to 24 grantees: 11 emerging artists, 9 established artists and 4 arts administrators, funding 46.9 percent of eligible requests totaling \$68,350. 45 eligible applications received, with requests totaling \$68,350,

- from Lake (3), Orange (35), Osceola (1) and Seminole (6) counties

24 grant awards: 11 emerging artists (scoring 17.66 & above out of 20 total points), 9 established artists (scoring 18.54 & above), and 4 arts administrators.
