

NARRATIVE: The undersigned has probable cause to believe the above-named defendant on the 22 of September 2014 at 23:22 at BONNEVILLE DR/HERTHA AV (Zone: 22) in Orange County did

On 09/22/14 at approximately 2322 hours, I was traveling north on Bonneville Drive approaching the intersection of Hertha Avenue, Orange County, Florida. At that time, I observed a vehicle turn south on Bonneville Drive from Hertha Avenue heading directly towards me. I activated my high beams and as the vehicle was passing me, I noticed the driver was not seat belted which I could clearly see through the windshield. I then made a U-turn at Hertha Avenue and caught up to the vehicle just north of Aloho Way at the S-curve. The vehicle was a silver Honda bearing Florida license plate number 627 8PS. In the S-curve, the vehicle began to pull into a driveway on the east side of the road. I activated my emergency lights to my marked Orange County Sheriff's Office patrol vehicle. The vehicle was stopped toward the end of the driveway closer to the street. I pulled up at an angle with my patrol vehicle facing the driver side of the vehicle. I began to exit out of my patrol vehicle to approach the Honda with my spot light activated shining on the driver. I noticed the driver was white female and was the only occupant in the vehicle. While still behind the driver door, the driver later identified as Shawna Schaefer put the vehicle in reverse, accelerated at a high rate of speed striking the front of my patrol vehicle with the rear driver side fender of her vehicle. When she struck my vehicle, my vehicle shook abruptly causing my driver door to strike me. She then backed out onto Bonneville Drive after striking my vehicle, put the vehicle into drive, and accelerated at a high rate of speed south on Bonneville Drive. Due to her ramming my patrol vehicle which caused me to be struck by my own vehicle, I pursued after her with my lights and sirens activated. The vehicle continued south on Bonneville Drive and approached East Colonial Drive. The vehicle turned east on East Colonial Drive then turning north on Lake Pickett Drive. With speeds reaching 80 MPH, the vehicle began to pass other vehicles in a no passing zone causing oncoming vehicle to swerve off the roadway to avoid being struck endangering their lives. The vehicle continued north on Lake Pickett Road until coming to the Percival Road and Lake Pickett Road split. The vehicle turned east on Lake Pickett Road and then made a left turn heading north on North Tanner Road. The vehicle continued north on North Tanner Road reaching speeds in excess of 90 MPH. As the vehicle approached the steady red light at North Tanner Road and Mcculloch Road, the vehicle failed to stop at the red light and continued through it at speeds of approximately 70 MPH. When the vehicle ran the red light, other traffic which had the green light, had to take evasive action to avoid striking the vehicle. North Tanner Road now turns into Old Lockwood Road as it crosses Mcculloch Road into Seminole County. Still pursuing the vehicle with my lights and sirens activated, the vehicle continued north on Old Lockwood Road at speeds in excess of 80 MPH in a residential area. The vehicle then approached Lockwood Road, failed to stop at the stop sign and continued north on Lockwood Road. The vehicle continued to accelerate with speeds reaching 100 MPH on Lockwood Road until reaching East Mitchell Hammock Road. The vehicle then turned west on East Mitchell Hammock Road and accelerated to speeds of 100 MPH. As the vehicle went under the SR 417, East Mitchell Hammock Road now turned to Red Bug Lake Road. The vehicle continued to pass vehicles in a reckless manner which caused those vehicles to take evasive action. When the vehicle reached Tuskawilla Road, the vehicle crossed into the east bound lanes still heading west bound going head on with oncoming vehicles. The vehicle continued in the east bound lanes going head on with other vehicles at approximately 80 MPH. Many vehicles began swerving off the road to avoid being hit head on at such high speeds which posed a severe threat to the public. The Honda continued at a high rate of speed, still driving against oncoming traffic. I stayed in the west bound lanes paralleling the vehicle with my lights and sirens still activated. The vehicle continued to drive against traffic, causing vehicles to run off the road until approaching East Semoran Boulevard. The vehicle continued through the extremely busy intersection going against traffic and not stopping or slowing down. As the vehicle entered the intersection, many more vehicles had to take evasive action to avoid being struck. The vehicle then turned south on E Semoran Boulevard and crossed over into the correct south bound lanes heading south. The vehicle continued to accelerate at a high rate, swerving around vehicles until reaching Lake Howell Road. The vehicle made a quick right onto Lake Howell Road which then continues south. While on Lake Howell Road, the vehicle was reaching speeds of 80 MPH. While on Lake Howell Road, the vehicle struck several speed bumps. When the vehicle struck the speed bumps, it caused the vehicle to go airborne making all four tires leave the pavement. When the vehicle landed, a large amount of sparks came out of the bottom of the vehicle. The vehicle continued around the curves still driving at a high rate of speed swerving around other vehicles which put driver's lives in danger. Lake Howell Road then turns into North Lakemont Avenue. The vehicle continued south on Lakemont Avenue, still driving recklessly until reaching Aloma Avenue. The vehicle then turned east on Aloma Avenue. Still with pure disregard for the safety of the public, the vehicle continued at a high rate of speed until reaching North Semoran Boulevard. The light at Aloma Avenue and North Semoran Boulevard was a steady red with heavy traffic traveling south on Semoran Boulevard. The vehicle ran through the light and turned south onto North Semoran Boulevard cutting off several vehicles which

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also had to take evasive action to avoid being struck. The vehicle continued on North Semoran Boulevard heading south. While the vehicle was continuing south on North Semoran Boulevard, the vehicle was swerving around other vehicles in traffic posing an immediate danger to other drivers. The vehicle then turned east on University Boulevard and continued accelerating at a high rate of speed swerving around vehicles. Speeds reached approximately 70 MPH. As the vehicle was approaching University Boulevard and North Mira Drive, the vehicle attempted to make the left turn onto North Mira Drive into the neighborhood. Due to the high rate of speed of the vehicle, the vehicle was unable to successfully make the left turn sliding into the bushes and crashing into the entrance wall to the neighborhood. I observed a white female exit out of the driver door with a black purse in hand and flee on foot running east along the neighborhood wall. I exited out of my patrol vehicle and pursued after her yelling "get on the ground now!" After approximately fifty feet, I pushed the female with an open hand causing her to fall to the ground. I then secured her with handcuffs without further issue, with the assistance of Cpl. Wright (EID 4083). After securing her, she stated [REDACTED]!" I then assisted in getting her up and escorted her back to my patrol vehicle. The female was identified by her Florida driver's license as Shawna Schaefer. I read Schaefer her Miranda Rights which she stated she understood. I asked her to tell me what happened tonight and she stated [REDACTED]" I asked her why she hit my patrol vehicle and she stated [REDACTED]" I asked her why she just didn't pull over during the entire pursuit and she stated [REDACTED]" I asked her about going head on with vehicles on Red Bug Lake Road and she stated [REDACTED]" I asked her why she ran into the wall and she stated [REDACTED]" In her purse, I located a hypodermic needle. I asked her what she used it for and she stated [REDACTED]" Upon running Schaefer in DHSMV, she showed to have numerous suspensions on her driver's license with two prior convictions. During the pursuit, I maintained a constant visual of the vehicle and observed no other occupants in the vehicle. Schaefer showed no regard for public safety and put many lives in danger. The total time of the pursuit upon initiation until she was secured was twenty minutes with speeds reaching in excess of 100 MPH on wet rainy roads. My patrol vehicle sustained minor damage to the push bumper. I was not injured during the incident nor was Schaefer. Based on the conclusion of my investigation, I concluded probable cause existed for the arrest of Schaefer for aggravated battery on a law enforcement officer with a motor vehicle, fleeing and eluding high speed with pure disregard, resisting an officer without violence, possession of drug paraphernalia, and driving while license suspended with knowledge. She was transported to BRC for processing. The needle was placed into evidence. The vehicle was towed by Johnson's Wrecker. Schaefer was issued two citations. Seat belt violation A0DP11P and driving while license suspended with knowledge A0DP10P.
