Comes now the affiant, **Ofc. B. Stahl (34831)**, a sworn law enforcement officer, to wit: **a police officer** for the **Orlando Police Department**, submitted via a secure electronic file system before the issuing judge, **in and for Orange County, Florida, Ninth Judicial Circuit**, who makes this affidavit and states under oath that affiant has probable cause to believe that certain laws have been violated in **Orange County, Florida**, and that on/between **02/27/2022**, the Defendant, **BIANCA LIZZETTE MONTANEZ**, did violate Florida State Statute(s), and commit the offense(s) of:

C1: Aggravated Battery with a Deadly Weapon**FSS: 784.045(1)(A)(2)**

Your affiant, **Ofc. B. Stahl (34831)**, is and has been since **04/05/2020**, a duly sworn **police officer**, with the **Orlando Police Department, Florida**.

YOUR AFFIANT, IN THE COURSE OF THEIR OFFICIAL DUTIES, HAS COME TO INVESTIGATE:

On **02/27/2022** at approximately **0305** hours, I, **Ofc. B. Stahl (34831)** responded to a call for service reference a battery located at [REDACTED]. Upon arrival at the scene, I met with the victim later identified by his FL/DL as, **Joshua Martin**, who advised me of the following incident.

Prior to the arrival of law enforcement, Martin stated he was in a verbal disagreement with his current girlfriend, later identified by her FL/DL as, **Bianca Montanez**, at **Backstage Billiards** located on **International Drive**. Martin advised the argument continued when both parties arrived home at their residence which is the above listed address. During the argument inside the apartment, Martin stated Montanez obtained her car keys to leave the area. The vehicle involved in this incident is a **2019 Gold Honda** bearing FL passenger tag **NMNT59**, which Martin advised was parked on the North side parking lot of the apartment building. Montanez is one of the current registered owners of this vehicle.

Martin stated after Montanez entered the vehicle, he was standing alongside of it continuing to talk to her to de-escalate the situation. While Montanez was being uncooperative, Martin then re-positioned himself in the middle of the roadway. Martin then stated Montanez pulled out of the parking space turning right such as to face him head on. Martin stated the vehicle came to a stop and

he told her if she wants to leave, she will have to leave the other direction through the parking lot. It is to be noted, the parking lot connects all the way around back to the main road on Northbridge Drive, thus offering an opportunity for Montanez to leave in a different direction. Shortly after, Martin stated Montanez accelerated the vehicle striking him head on. Martin was tossed several feet after being struck by the vehicle and sustained several injuries to include cuts to the right leg, left ankle, left palm and swelling behind the right shoulder. Martin also complained of significant pain to his left wrist and his head.

Martin stated the suspect fled the scene and has not returned since. While on scene, contact was made with a witness to the incident later identified by her FL/DL as My-Lynh Le who provided a sworn written statement. Le stated she witnessed Martin get struck by the vehicle and was able to confirm she recognizes the vehicle and Montanez as the driver of the vehicle during this incident.

Both parties have been in an intimate relationship for the past 3 years making this a domestic violence incident. Contact was unable to be made with Montanez, as Martin stated she is not in possession of her phone due to it being lost. Based on the investigation, probable cause exists to charge Montanez with violation of FSS 784.045 (1)(A)(2), Aggravated Battery with a Deadly Weapon, due to the vehicle being used in the incident. An arrest warrant is being requested at this time.
