I worked as a tablet operator from August 8, 2022 to August 15, 2022 for Early Voting at the Alafaya Public Library Branch. I was instructed by the Clerk, Linda and Assistant Clerk Dottie, not open the vote by mail envelopes and write cancel on the ballots as instructed by the computer system. At this site there are three tablet operators and we were all instructed to not write cancel on the ballots.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Alafaya Branch location is 12000 E. Colonial Dr. Orlando FL 32826. The Orange County Elections Office is 119 W. Kaley Street Orlando FL 32806. I worked as a Tablet Operator in prior election years and I had no concerns at that time. I am only referring to the time frame of August 2022. I was hired by the Kelly Temporary Agency to work as a Tablet Operator for Early Voting for the Orange County Elections Office for Early Voting August 2022. During Early Voting I was instructed onsite by the Clerk, Linda C. and Assistant Clerk Dottie Magill (phone 4072347112.) to not open the vote by mail ballots and write cancel on them. When a voter originally requested a vote by mail ballot but decides to vote in the booth instead they can return to vote by mail ballot at the voting site. They surrender the ballot to the tablet operator. The computer asks us if they have a ballot to surrender. We click on "yes" if they do. The computer then asks if I wrote cancel on the ballot and envelope. I should click on "yes" and then a new ballot is issued and the vote by mail ballot is invalidated by writing on it. By instructing us not to write cancel on the ballot it can potentially be used to vote with. I invalidated all of my vote by mail ballots according to the computer prompting but I was harrassed by the clerk and assistant clerk to stop opening the envelopes and writing on the ballots so I was dismissed from the position in August 15, 2022 at 9:23am. On August 15, 2022, I sent an email communication to the Orange County Elections Office with my concerns. At 1:25pm on August 15, 2022, I received a call from Lymari Perez (phone 4072546599) in response to my Email. She informed that she is the trainer and the clerks were acting to her directions and that she did not want the envelopes open or cancel written on the ballots. I still believe this directive is wrong and fraudulent.
